Club Meeting Demonstration

This month's demo by Tod Raines is a spindle turning of a small bud vase. Sometimes called a weed pot but this smaller vase has a unique feature. At about 4.25" tall and 1.75" wide it is simple and quick to turn, and they make a great gift. They also allow for experimenting with different woods and finishes. Add some color or pyrography or both. Very few tools are needed for this project – typically just a skew, spindle gouge and parting tool.

Empty Bowls and Beads of Courage by Lou Boudreaux

Forty-Four Beads of Courage boxes from DAW members were given to seriously ill kids at Children's Hospital in time for Christmas. So far this year members have donated 49 BoC boxes, so it looks like we will surpass the DAW goal for the year of 50 Boxes; in addition, we collected 12 boxes from non-members. So far members have donated only 102 bowls toward the current DAW goal of 300 Empty Bowls. We only have January and February meetings before the Empty Bowls event. Hopefully, everyone will make a push to turn some Empty Bowls so we can meet our goal for this worthy cause. David Cramer who is responsible for collecting and organizing all the items for Empty Bowls will be at our January meeting to brief our members on this North Texas Food Bank program and review prior year results.
