Library News - Mark and Diane Montgomery

New items this month include the Oct & Nov issues of Woodturning magazine, issues of Turning Point magazines and other books donated by Steve Worcester, plus two new videos by Phil Holtan on beginning turning and turning bowls.

Library listings are posted on our website for you to look up the books, magazines, and videos prior to our club meeting. There are listing alphabetically by author and title for each of the type of media.

Our library collection currently has 48 AAW symposium videos, 373 SWAT videos, 188 DAW demo videos, 221 commercial videos, 420 magazines, and 1859 books; that's a total of more than 1400 different woodturning references for checkout from our library.

Upcoming Open Shop Activities:

WE WILL HAVE OPEN SHOP ON October 21, Following our regular D.A.W. Meeting on Thursday October 17! The theme will be bowl turning and sharpening your tools and general Q and A time. Or, bring your special projects to Open Shop.

Open Shops run from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. at Wood World.

1) Please remember to park in the alley behind the store.

2) All stock prep needs to be done previously before coming to Open Shop. *If stock prep is necessary at Wood World, ask Wood World Employees to assist in the use of any Wood World Machinery.

3) All members attending Open Shop must adhere to the A.A.W. Safety Rules Guidelines...handouts will be provided at Open Shop. These safety Guidelines include - wearing a face shield while turning, (face shields are available for loan or purchase), and wearing leather shoes when working at the Open shop.

4) Please check your tool bags and boxes before leaving Open Shop, too insure that all D.A.W. Tools have been returned to the Lathe Tool Box you checked out at the Open Shop. Also, make sure you have all of your personal tools accounted for.....your personal tools should be marked before bringing them to Open shop.




